FEATHERED FRIENDS

Here are a few recipe's to help our
feathered friends back from a long
flight from the warmer climate.

Super suet recipe

3-6 cups raw oatmeal

Gourmet suet recipe

1 cup lard or bacon grease
1 cup crunchy peanutbutter
2 cups cornmeal
1 cup white flower
2 cups bird seed
Mix all ingredients and store in the

something suitable and put it out
for the birds.
